Minimum Stage Size – 32' (10m) Wide, 20' (6.5m) Deep.

Stage and Wings MUST BE ROOFED

Stage Deck to Trim – 32' (9.75m)

Fly Bar or Truss to accommodate Back Drop 32' x 32' (9.75m x 9.75m)

Drum Riser – One (1) Carpeted 8' x 8' x 2' (2.4m x 2.4m x 0.60m)

SOUND CHECK:

<u>For All Headlining & Direct Support Performances</u> a Last In Line Sound Check is Mandatorily Required.

Once back line is set and staged, instruments are mic'd and pined, a full line check is performed and it is determined that all systems components are fully functional, Sound Check should usually take 1 hour or less to complete.

For All Support and Festival Performances where a full sound check is unavailable, **Please** schedule realistic turnover and line check times.

Down Stage Truss:

Must be capable of keeping all performers brightly lit at all times.

Mid & Up Stage Truss:

Must be capable of creating stage color scenes and moods complimentary to the on stage performance.

FOLLOW SPOTS:

Three (3) follow spots with Three (3) experienced spot operators must be provided. There **MUST** be Clear Com communications between FOH lighting position and follow spot operators.

BACK DROP

We travel with a 32' x 32' (9.75m x 9.75m) Back Drop. Please inform us if there are any hanging limitations.

Static digital hi-res back drop images are available for LED Wall back drops.



LAST IN LINE DRESSING ROOM & CATERING REQUIREMENTS

DRESSING ROOMS:

Must be set up and accessible at the time of load in. Promoter agrees to provide Two (2) comfortable, clean and private dressing rooms, large enough to seat seven (7), free from public access for the sole use of the Artist. These rooms shall be clean, dry, well lit, heated or air-conditioned, as the season requires. Full Length Mirrors and large garment rack with hangers are a *must* in each dressing room. Dressing Rooms must have lockable doors with keys. Dressing rooms shall have private bathrooms and shower facilities for the sole use of the Artist. Rooms shall also be freshly supplied with soap, towels, paper towels, tissues, and toilet tissue. In a situation where there are no permanent structure dressing rooms a Large RV or tour bus must be provided as a dressing room facility. Said facility must have shore power, running water and climate control. Tents, pop up's and Easy up's *are not* an acceptable form of a dressing room facility.

PRODUCTION OFFICE:

Promoter also agrees to provide one (1) clean, well lit Production Office, Internet (and or WiFi) service and printing capabilities for the exclusive use of Last In Line.

TOWELS:

Artist will require Twelve (12) clean large bath towels (35" x 70") and Ten (10) clean hand towels (16" x 26") to be placed in dressing room upon load in arrival. Promoter agrees that Artist will not be required to pay for or place a deposit on said towels. The towels must be real towels, no bar rags please.

MEALS:

Promoter agrees to provide proper Lunch and Dinner meals for 7 persons. One set of these lunch and dinner meals is to be Pescatarian . *Pescatarian being absolutely no meat or poultry. Fish is acceptable.* Suggestions are, Fish, Pasta, Quality Veggie Burgers, Vegetables. If the meal requirements are unable to be met a meal buy out is acceptable. Buyout breakdown is \$25.00 per meal per person. Two proper meals per person per show day.

DRESSING ROOM / GREEN ROOM / or BUS CATERING:

Catering requirements location to be determined at time of advance.

Please include an adequate amount of plates, bowels, cups, napkins and flatware.

1 Coffee Station to be replenished throughout the day / night.

Station to be supplied with sugar, sweeteners, non-dairy flavored creamers and one quart of half & half

1 Tea Station to be replenished throughout the day / night.

Unlimited supply of clean crushed ice.

DRESSING ROOM INVENTORY:

All food & beverages are to be set up in dressing room 1 hour prior to soundcheck. Catering personnel should continue to ice down beverages throughout the night as needed.

LAST IN LINE HOTELS & TRANSPORTATION

HOTELS:

The Last In Line touring party will require a total of seven (7) hotel rooms per night from the day of arrival to the day of departure. Hotels are to be of or affiliates of Reputable Hotel Chains. Clean and Secure. Rooms are to be king size (a room with a king-sized bed). Individual In Room Climate Control of Heating and Air Conditioning is required for each room. Hotels should also include a 24 hr. fitness center and available food / room service

GROUND TRANSPORTATION:

Transport to be provided to and from all airports, hotels and venues.

All transport drivers must be sober, professional drivers experienced in safely transporting multiple passenger transport vehicles.

Transport vehicles must be mechanically sound and safe, clean and comfortable with fully functioning air conditioning and heating.

There can be 6 to 8 persons in the Last In Line touring party with 15 plus pieces of gear and personal luggage. Some of the gear is in larger heavy and awkward shaped cases. For ground transport we will require **one** of the following three choices.

- 1. One15 Passenger Van/Sprinter Transport to *comfortably* fit all members of the touring party and one cargo van for gear and luggage.
- 2. One15 Passenger Van/Sprinter Transport to *comfortably* fit all members of the touring party with a trailer for the gear and luggage.
- 3. One Large Mercedes or Ford Transit 350 Style Passenger / Cargo Sprinter to *comfortably* fit all members of the touring party with rear cargo area to adequately accommodate all gear and luggage.

All Assigned Transportation is to be for the exclusive use of Last In Line and Last In Line personnel Only. Hotel or Airport Shuttle services <u>are not</u> acceptable means of transport. Please inform Transportation Providers that Band, Management, Production and Crew Personnel may be traveling at different or staggered times.

TRANSPORT CONTACTS:

Direct mobile phone contacts of All transport drivers, Transport Companies and runners must be made available to Last In Line's Tour Management at the time of advance.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION BUYOUT:

If the performance purchaser requests a contracted ground transportation buyout the buyout fee will be all inclusive of the vehicles rental rate, rental insurance and fuel costs. In the case of any event where a vehicle rental situation is unobtainable or arranged contracted show transport fails to provide scheduled pick ups / drop offs between airports, hotels and venues the purchaser will be deemed responsible for the full reimbursement of any transportation expenses incurred by the Last In Line organization.

RUNNER:

On day of show please provide for the Last In Line tour party an experienced reliable runner with vehicle and a mobile phone contact.

LAST IN LINE SECURITY / MERCHANDISING / MEET & GREET / MEDIA

SECURITY:

In addition to proper security in all public areas, Promoter shall provide experienced, licensed professional security personnel for the protection of the Artist, Artist's equipment, persons who are traveling with the Artist, other personal property of Artist and said persons. A licensed experienced security guard will be required to escort Last In Line and the band to and from the stage. Competent licensed security guards must be present near the dressing rooms and back stage areas throughout the day and night.

MERCHANDISE:

Promoter/Venue agrees to provide Last In Line an **experienced** merchandise seller at no additional cost to the artist. It is also agreed that promoter / **venue will provide a proper well lit vending area** to adequately display and sell Last In Line merchandise. Merchandise may consist of multiple "T" shirt and jersey designs, tote bags, photos, posters, CD's, DVD's, books, guitar picks, trinkets and drumsticks. Last In Line's tour manager will supply merchandise pricing sheet and a count in/out inventory form to the seller.

The name, image or likeness of the Artist may not be used or associated, directly or indirectly with any product or service without the Artist's written consent.

MEET & GREETS:

Last In Line has its own pre-sold private Meet & Greet, coordinated through their website. Said Meet & Greet occurs at 5pm during artists sound check. Promoter / Venue will provide space and licensed professional security personnel at the meet and greet area. Promoter / Venue will also provide tables and seating for Last In Line's 4 band member autograph signing. Last In Line's Meet & Greet experience is not subject to venue merchandise percentage fees.

Last In Line will accommodate promoters VIP meet and greets on a show-by-show basis. These meet and greets are pre-arranged and promoted appearances. All meet and greets are additional paid appearance packages paid to Last In Line and are not included in the general ticket pricing. Meet & Greet times can vary but will usually take place before Last In Line's performance. Meet and Greet format <u>MUST</u> be clearly advertised. For example Step & Repeat photo op, Signing, Photo op & Signing. Licensed professional security personnel must be at the meet and greet area. Meet and greets are to be held in a secure area out of general populous. Promoter/Venue is to arrange all Meet & Greet logistics through Last In Line's tour management.

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MEDIA:

Venue Video / Audio Recordings & Streaming

At no time may the promoter, venue or any outside third party video capture, audio record or live stream a Last In Line performance without full prior discussion, negotiation and written consent from Last In Line's management. If at any time an agreement is reached to record video/audio and or stream the performance it is understood that the Last In Line organization is to receive full copies of all captured media and broadcasts. All media capture and broadcast discussions and logistics are to be discussed prior to the event date with Last In Line's Tour & Personal Management.

PRESS & MEDIA REQUESTS:

Please forward all press and media request to Artist's representative.

All requests are subject to approval and scheduled based on Artist's availability.

TICKETING:

OBSTRUCTED VIEW TICKETS

At no time shall seating be sold located to the rear of the stage where staging, set pieces or production equipment is impairing normal eye level viewing of the artist's performance, unless the location of the seating is clearly advertised at the time of sale and indicated "Obstructed Viewing" on the ticket.

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

Purchaser agrees at his or her sole expense to provide artist with twenty (20) complimentary tickets. These tickets shall be located in either a VIP section or a premium seating area.
